Give the college leadership a little bit of time. Information will go out ASAP.● There is wiggle room in the academic calendar in case of all these class cancellations. Its always best to check in with your Dean and the VPI office.● When adding these emergency closures to your timesheet, please speak with your supervisor.● While there has been a lot of planning for in-person courses (planned for 40% online, 60% in person) however, that isn't
