Are they going to build more for our employees? - What about stipends for people who are still stuck on the waitlist and impacted by housing insecurity? - How are we going to manage student housing? It is hard for us who have to face students to explain and justify why they don't get it. You have to be very specific about your educational goal because it's tied to degree completion (certificate/associates).

<p>Classified feedback Chancellor's Search Committee</p>	<p>Board approved language and maintained the right to pull a candidate as a finalist even if they weren't put forward by the Search Committee. It appears that we at Cañada are the only ones not mollified by the decision of the Board of Trustees.</p> <p>Our members were in agreement that it appears to be a sham if the Search Committee can be overridden by the Board of Trustees. It seems like a waste of time. It would also taint the legitimacy of the next chancellor.</p> <p>It really isn't a good look for our district, not a positive reputation in the committee.</p> <p>District HR has already put out the request for participants and you can sign up on their web link. It is your choice since it appears they have taken recommendation power from governance groups such as Academic Senate and Classified Senate.</p>
