

What is Dual Enrollment?

The Dual Enrollment Program, also known as College and Career Access Pathways (CCAP), is a partnership between Cañada College and our local high school partners to increase the accessibility of college courses to underrepresented high school students or students who may not be college bound. We aim to provide equitable opportunities for students to develop a college-going mindset and pathway to graduate with a certificate/associate degree, transfer, or join the workforce.

What is Concurrent Enrollment?

The College Connection Concurrent Enrollment Program allows students to enroll in Cañada College courses while they are still in high school. It is designed to provide current high school students, who have completed the 8th grade or higher at the time of entering a course, the opportunity to get an “early start” on their college experience.

Steps to Register

STEP 1

- Apply to Cañada College
- Visit: canadacollege.edu
- Click on “Apply”
- Click on “New Student”
- Create a CCCApply account

STEP 2

Meet with your high school counselor for course recommendations and to review course offerings visit webschedule.smccd.edu

STEP 3

- Complete the College Connection Form in your [mySMCCD Student Portal](#)
- Click on “Student Success Link”
- Click on “My Forms” tab and select “College Connection Form”

STEP 4

- Complete Math or English Placement (if the desired class has an English or Math prerequisite)
- Email your high school transcript to canadaplacement@smccd.edu

STEP 5

- Once documentation has been approved you will receive an email regarding the registration process
