ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE GENENTECH FOUNDATION

Skyline College has been awarded a \$130,000 Genentech Foundation grant to fund the coordination and expansion of work-based learning opportunities for students along with the development of internship and job placements in Biotechnology and other Bioscience fields.
