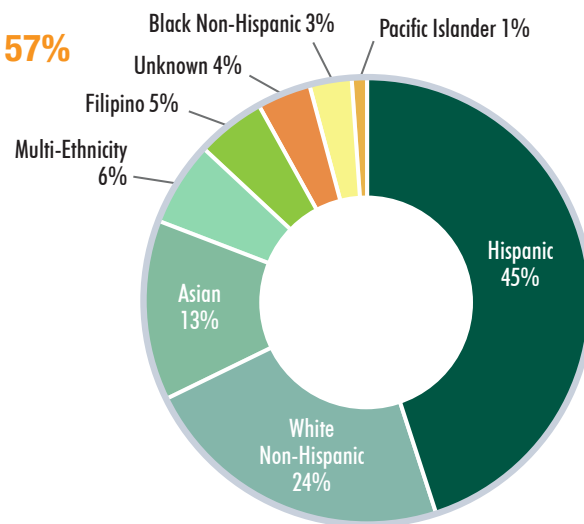
FALL 2023 STUDENT PROFILE

GENDER



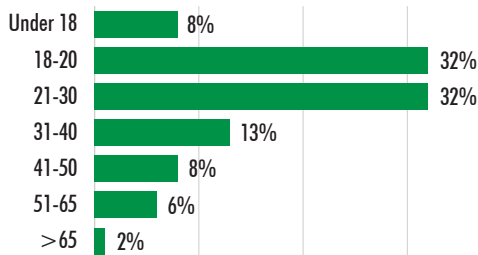

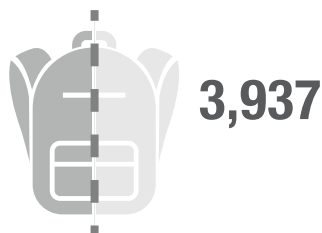


FALL 2023 ENROLLMENT

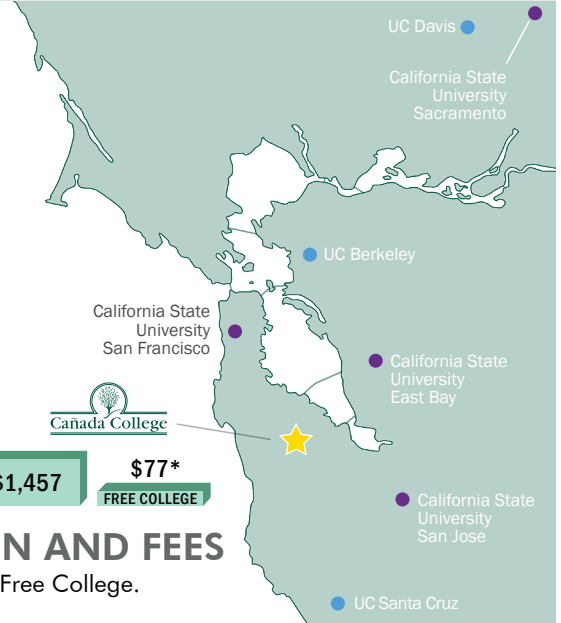
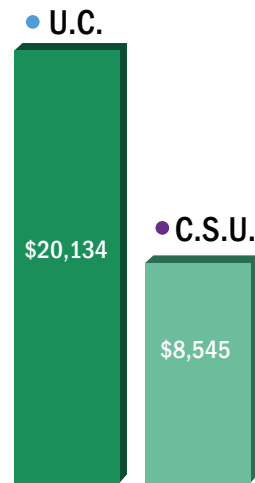
