#### **New Enhanced Gradebook Filters in Canvas**

This Fall Canvas rolled out enhanced gradebook filters to their gradebook feature. This new feature includes minor updates to the interface and design of Canvas Gradebook. View options such as how to arrange the gradebook columns, display the notes column, and/or display unpublished assignments are now located within the gradebook settings (gear icon). Instructors can also create filters that can be saved or used one time using criteria such as assignment groups, student groups, and Modules. Moreover, Canvas added two additional filters for status and submissions. These filters make it easier to filter out for students that have resubmitted assignments or for students who have submitted assignments and have not yet been graded.
