What are Strategic Initiatives?

- 1. Objectives to achieve the goals of the EMP
- 2. Major priorities that aim to transform the college
- "Big ideas" that require a significant investment of financial resources, personnel, physical resources and time to implement

A Strategic Initiative...

- ✓ Is specific and actionable
- ✓ Is based on evidence of potential for successful impact
- ✓ Will require multiple years (2-5) to implement
- ✓ Has measureable outcomes

A Strategic Initiative...

May be something new to the college

Cañada Promise Program - a program offering financial assistance to reduce barriers to college attendance and encourage completion

Improved retention and completion of those participating Shortened time to completion

May scale up current efforts in a new, expanded, or integrated manner

Summer Bridge Program - expanding and integrating the COLTS Academy, Jams, and Mentoring services for all students

Increased number of participants
Improved placement and success of those participating
Shortened time to completion
