# **District HEERF Funding**

Three separate emergency relief packages have been released since May 2020 in response to COVID-19 as follows:

The <u>Coronavirus Aid</u>, <u>Relief</u>, <u>and Economic Security Act</u>, also known as the CARES Act or HEERF I.

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, also known as CRRSAA or HEERF II.

The American Rescue Plan is also known as ARP or HEERF III.

# **HEERF Allocation**

• The three Colleges and the District have been allocated a total of \$44.5M in HEERF funds.

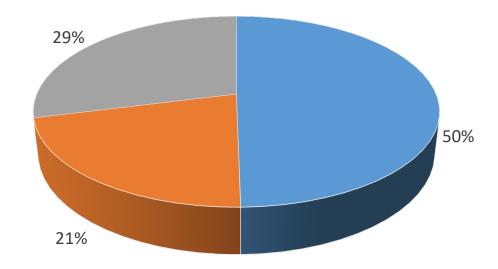

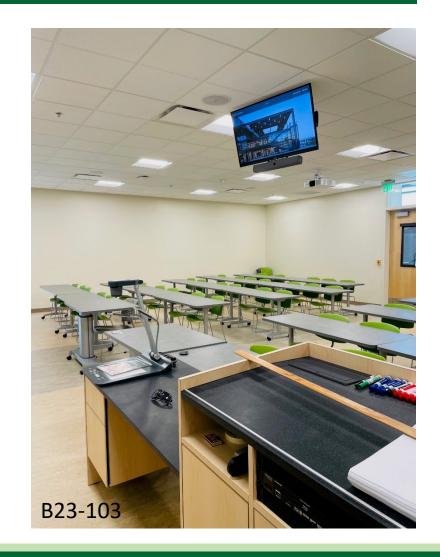
