- Reach new community members in N. Fair Oaks, Belle Haven, and East Palo Alto, especially BIPOC communities
- Transform where we share what Cañada has to offer by identifying and reaching new outreach audiences that help strengthen our ties to BIPOC communities
- Recruit more BIPOC students, including more students who identify as Black / African American
- Collaborate with community organizations to host summer camps, events, and other activities and programs that help triple the number of high school students on campus during the summer and on Saturdays during the academic year, particularly students who may not be college aware or on track to be college ready.


