Cost: \$30,000

 If we are able to transition from the Retention Specialist position, it will only cost the college a third of what it would require to hire another position. This cost effective strategy is a win-win for our students and the college

Coordinate Student Services

As we expand our services, a transition to a Program Services coordinator will help the needs of evening students in scheduling counseling appointments and direct support when services are unavailable at night (A&R, Financial Aid, etc.)



Support Academic Programs

This position will collaborate with other academic programs to be an extension of support for their evening students. The PSC will have the opportunity to recommend evening students academic programs that fit their needs. (Part-Time Promise, EOPS, TRIO etc.)



Proactive Registration

Transitioning to a Program Services Coordinator provides an opportunity to collaborate with faculty and support services in coordinating registration support to better serve our evening students.



Support Learning Communities

The Program Services Coordinator would continue the work of supporting PTK and Umoja. A transition to a PSC will help sustain this work and look to other communities for collaborations.

Maple Street Correctional Facilities

We are in the process of finalizing an MOU to collaborate with Maple Street Correctional Facilities. To continue this work, transitioning the role to a PSC aligns with our future plans in providing in-facility services.

Community Connections

Transition to a PSC can support in attending local community events to provide information about the college and our evening offerings.

Job Train Collaboration

Our PSC can strengthen our connection to Job Train's alumni network in learning more about our college evening offerings. On-site support could be possible with a transition into this position.
