Method

- 1. Students placed by MMAP are students who used their high school transcript to be placed into college-level English in Fall 2015.
- 2. Students placed by Compass include those students who took a Compass Writing assessment test between March 1 and August 31 of the reporting year, did not use their transcript as placement and were placed into college-level English. These are the same cohorts as those reported in the enrollment analysis for the 12/15/15 presentation to the Board of Trustees.
- 3. Course outcome include English 100 taken either in summer or fall of reporting year.
