## Needs assessment for grants research

**Main difference between IR and Grants**: Services and programs funded by grants generally targets a specific group of students.

- A. Grants needs and Data System
  - 1. Some of the grant needs include:
    - i. A way to identify these students (tag) in IR database, counseling database, student learning center database.
    - Case management database -- TRIO uses Blumen; A2B uses Student Accesss;
      STEM uses SurveyGizmo and ad hoc Excel spreadsheets. Use for tracking student progress, provide timely intervention.
    - iii. Survey data collection tool. Expertise in developing, collecting, and reporting evaluation surveys.
    - iv. Standard simple data aggregation. For grant annual reporting. Currently, some grants utilizes Data Dashboard, data packets general specifically for grants.
    - v. Complex analysis, such as predicting student success based on amount and types of services received.
  - 2. What database/system/application we can create/use to support data collections
    - i. Create a tag in Banner for each program. Currently tags in Banner include TRIO, EOPS, MESA. Tags are not always accurate and may need to be done every term/year.
    - ii. Develop an interface in Argos (Data Dashboard) where data from multiple sources can be linked via student ID.
