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Middle College High School Study, Oct 2013

Study

After Linda meeting with the Middle College High School (MCHS) faculty, the team has come up with a list of research items that we would like to include in our presentation to the Board. The analysis comprise of two major sets of information: (a) HS graduates from MCHS and (b) all HS students from MCHS. The outcomes are to exam MCHS students' course taken patterns and completion as well as their demographics. In return of the study, the faculty and dean will be able to (a) celebrate the strengths of the program, (b) make recommendations on possible program improvement, and (c) next step. (Please see last page for detail request.)

Population

Two sets of population and outcomes were studied: (The student population files were provided by Linda Hayes (Kathy Smith).)

Population

1. HS graduates from MCHS:
 - a. 2010-11 HS graduates from MCHS
 - b. 2011-12 HS graduates from MCHS
 - c. 2012-13 HS graduates from MCHS
2. All HS students from MCHS:
 - a. 2010-11 all HS students from MCHS
 - b. 2011-12 all HS students from MCHS
 - c. 2012-13 all HS students from MCHS

Questions/Hypothesis

1. HS graduates from MCHS:
 - a. What were MCHS graduates' demographic patterns?
 - b. What were MCHS graduates' course taken patterns?
 - c. What were MCHS graduates' course success outcomes?
 - d. Did graduates continue at Cañada College after their high school graduation?
 - e. How would we know whether MCHS graduates have successfully transferred? (Soraya?)
2. All HS students from MCHS:
 - a. What were MCHS students' demographic patterns? First generation students (not sure whether to find this yet)? Educational level of parents (not sure whether to find this yet)?
 - b. What were MCHS students' course taken patterns?
 - c. What were MCHS students' course success outcomes?

Methodology

Simple descriptive statistics were performed for graduates in three academic years and for all students in three academic years.

Findings

1. HS graduates from MCHS:
 - a. What were MCHS graduates' demographic patterns?
 - There were 61 graduates for 2012-13; 41 graduates for 2011-12; 53 graduates for 2010-11.
 - There are more female students than male students.
 - The highest ethnicity group is white students, followed by Hispanic, and then varied.
 - Most students came from Woodside High school, Sequoia High School, Menlo-Atherton High School, or Carlmont High School.
 - Most students claimed that their educational goal is to complete credits for HS diploma and followed by earn AA/AS degree and transfer to 4 year university.
 - Students' age ranges are between 16 to 20 years old.
 - b. What were MCHS graduates' course taken patterns?
 - The average numbers of courses graduates took is between 12 to 19 courses for MCHS graduates on the lengths they were in Cañada College. (If graduates were in Cañada for 4 semesters (2 falls and 2 springs), they would take about 3 to 5 courses per semester.)
 - About 80% of the courses graduates took were in the categories of: "UC/CSU transferable", followed by "Not transferable/degree applicable" category.
 - c. What were MCHS graduates' course success outcomes?
 - The course success rates range from 75% to 80%. The transfer courses success rate are slightly higher between 76% and 80%. The non-transfer courses success rate range from 65% to 78%.
 - Individual course success rates are also included. Please see the appendix for details.
 - d. Did graduates continue at Cañada College after their high school graduation?
 - Yes, they did. There were between 42% and 63% of graduates continued in Cañada College in summer and/or fall semesters after their high school graduation.
 - The demographic of these graduates who stayed after graduation were similar with the graduates.
 - e. How would we know whether MCHS graduates have successfully transferred? (Soraya?)
 - Linda is going to check with Soraya and high schools.
2. All HS students from Middle College High School (MCHS):

- a. What were MCHS students' demographic patterns? First generation students (not sure whether to find this yet)? Educational level of parents (not sure whether to find this yet)?
 - There were 102 MCHS students for 2012-13; 95 for 2011-12; 96 for 2010-11.
 - MCHS student for 2012-13 consisted of 2011-12 and 2012-13 graduates; MCHS students for 2011-12 consisted of 2010-11 and 2011-12 graduates.
 - Therefore, their demographics are similar with the graduates.
 - There are more female students than male students.
 - The highest ethnicity group is white students, followed by Hispanic, and then varied.
 - Most students came from Woodside High school, Sequoia High School, Menlo-Atherton High School, or Carlmont High School.
 - Most students claimed that their educational goal is to complete credits for HS diploma and followed by earn AA/AS degree and transfer to 4 year university.
 - Students' age ranges are between 16 to 20 years old.
- b. What were MCHS students' course taken patterns?
 - About 80% of the courses graduates took were in the categories of: "UC/CSU transferable", followed by "Not transferable/degree applicable" category.
- c. What were MCHS graduates' course success outcomes?
 - The course success rates range from 74% to 79%. The transfer courses success rate are slightly higher between 76% and 80%. The non-transfer courses success rate range from 65% to 75%.
 - Individual course success rates are also included. Please see the appendix for details.

Conclusions

Summary

1. MCHS graduates and students have similar gender ratio as the College—more female than male; however the ethnicity composition of MCHS is different than the College. MCHS has higher percentage of white students than Hispanic students. The College has higher percentage of Hispanic students than white students.
2. The College average student load is 6.7 units. The MCHS students tended to take more units than 6.7. The average courses MCHS students took were 3-5 courses (about 9 units to 15 units).
3. Overall MCHS graduates and students are performing better (>70% success rate) than the College course success rate standard (70% success rate).

Things to Consider

1. Study the individual course success rate, especially one level below college English and math. These two gateway subjects could be obstacle for some MCHS students.
2. Evaluate MCHS students' Cañada's transcripts. They tended to take 3-5 courses per semester and 80% of the courses were UC/CSU transferable courses; therefore, if students took "right" courses during their 2 years in the College, they may be able to earn or close to earn an AA or AS degree.
3. Follow up with these students who are close to earning an AA, AS degree or certificate and actively remind them to get their degree or certificate; or if they have already had enough credits for degree or certificate, award them!
4. Consider to create a "pilot" pathway for MCHS to support them earn an AA, AS or certificate, or transfer to 4 year university.
5. Connect with high schools' counselors and better tracking MCHS's "transfer" to 4 year university.
6. Connect with UC and/or CSU where MCHS' students "transfer" or went and partner with them to build potential "transfer program."
