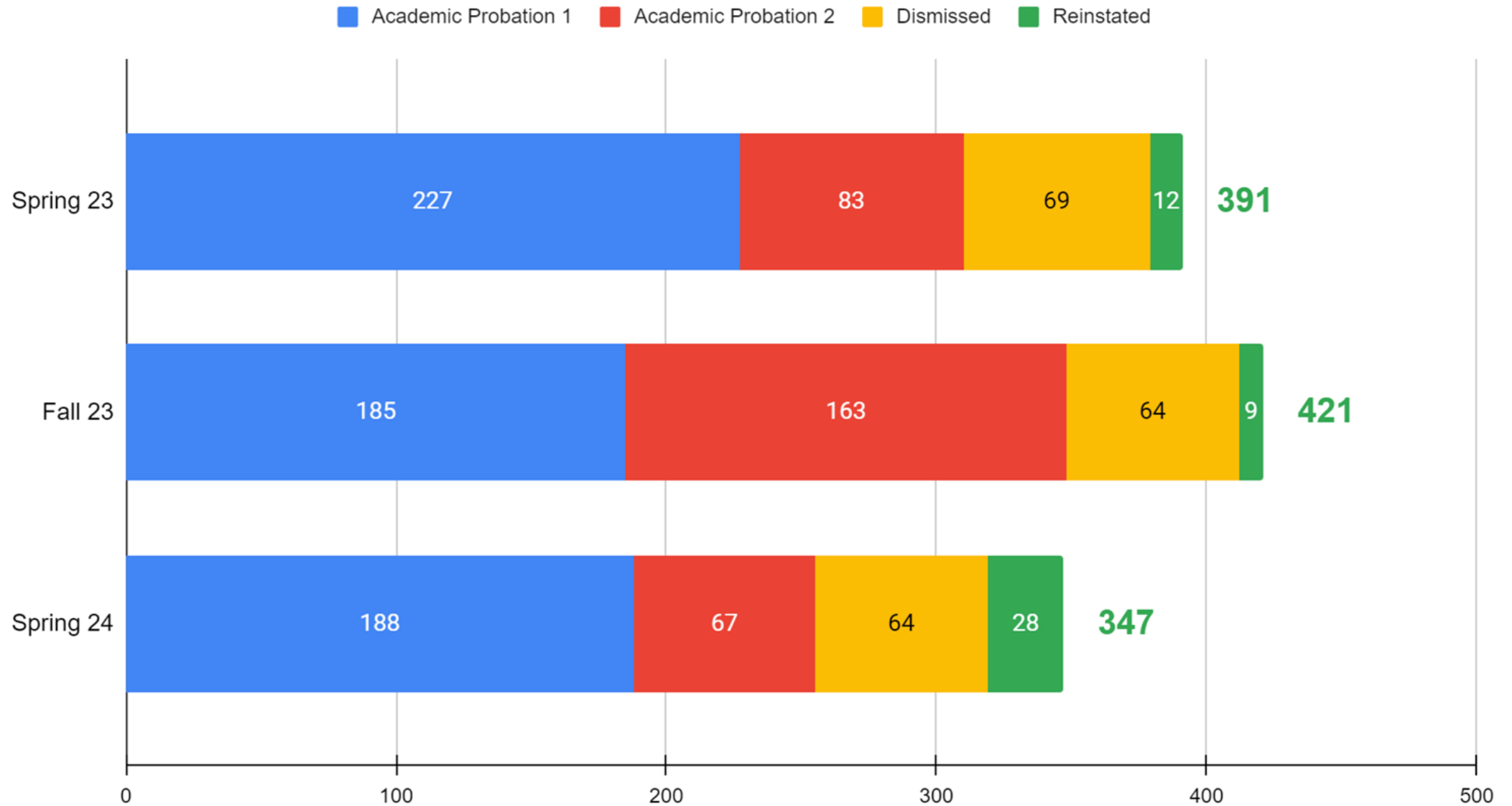
All of our data is sourced from PRIE reports submitted to the Coordinator on a weekly basis.

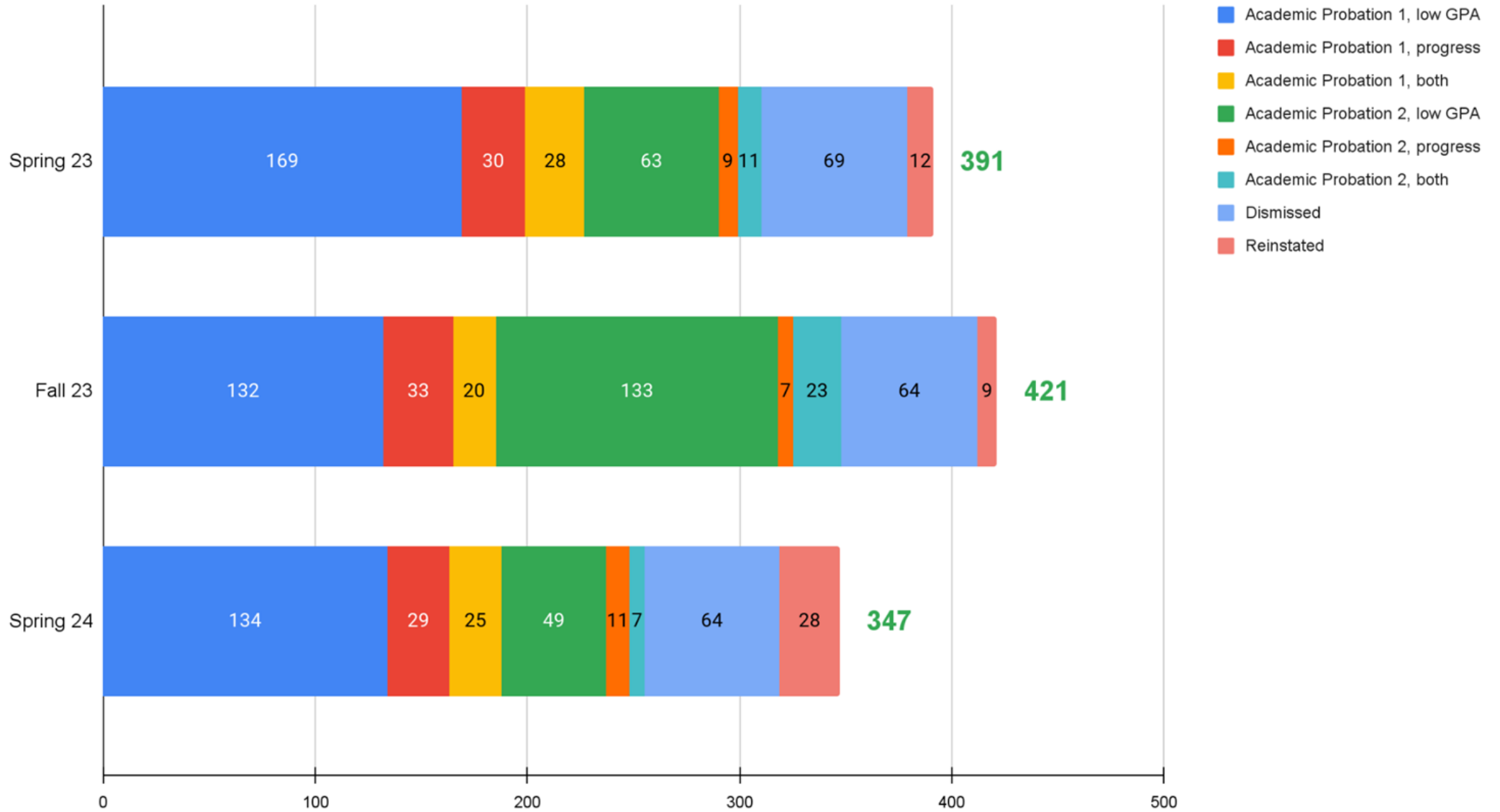

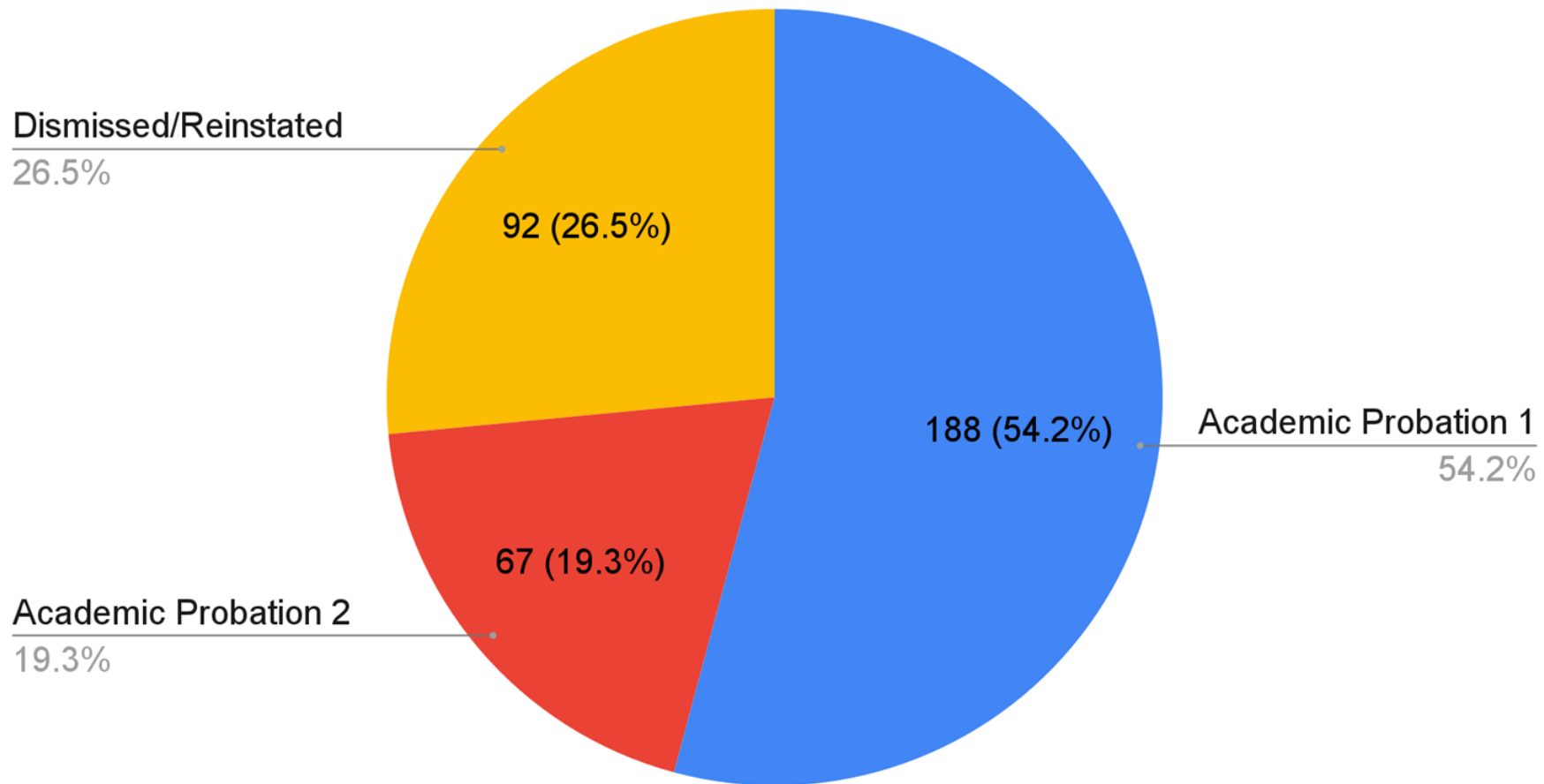


# Number of Students Categorized by Academic Probation Status

# What did we learn from all of this data?

(Part 1)

- ❖ The average number of students per semester under Academic Probation status is **386**
  - AP 1 student average = **200** (largest group every semester)
    - FA 23 and SP 24 are under average
- ❖ **Spring 24**
  - Has lowest amount of students on Academic Probation from data we have
  - Also seeing a low amount of Academic Probation 2 students
- ❖ **Prediction**
  - The number of Academic Probation 2 students will see an increase for **FALL 2024** as a result from being on Academic Probation 1 during this current **SPRING 24** semester

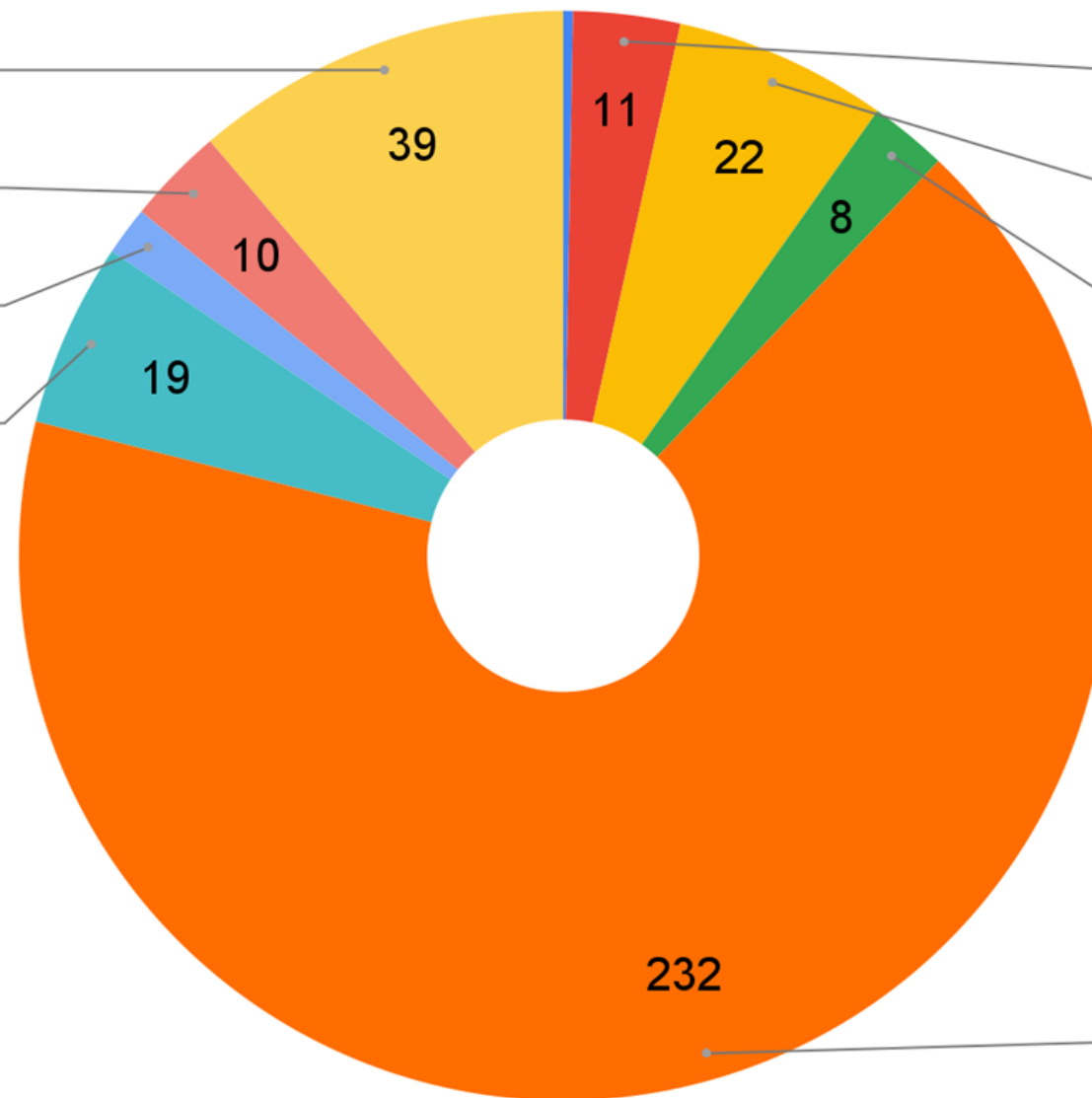

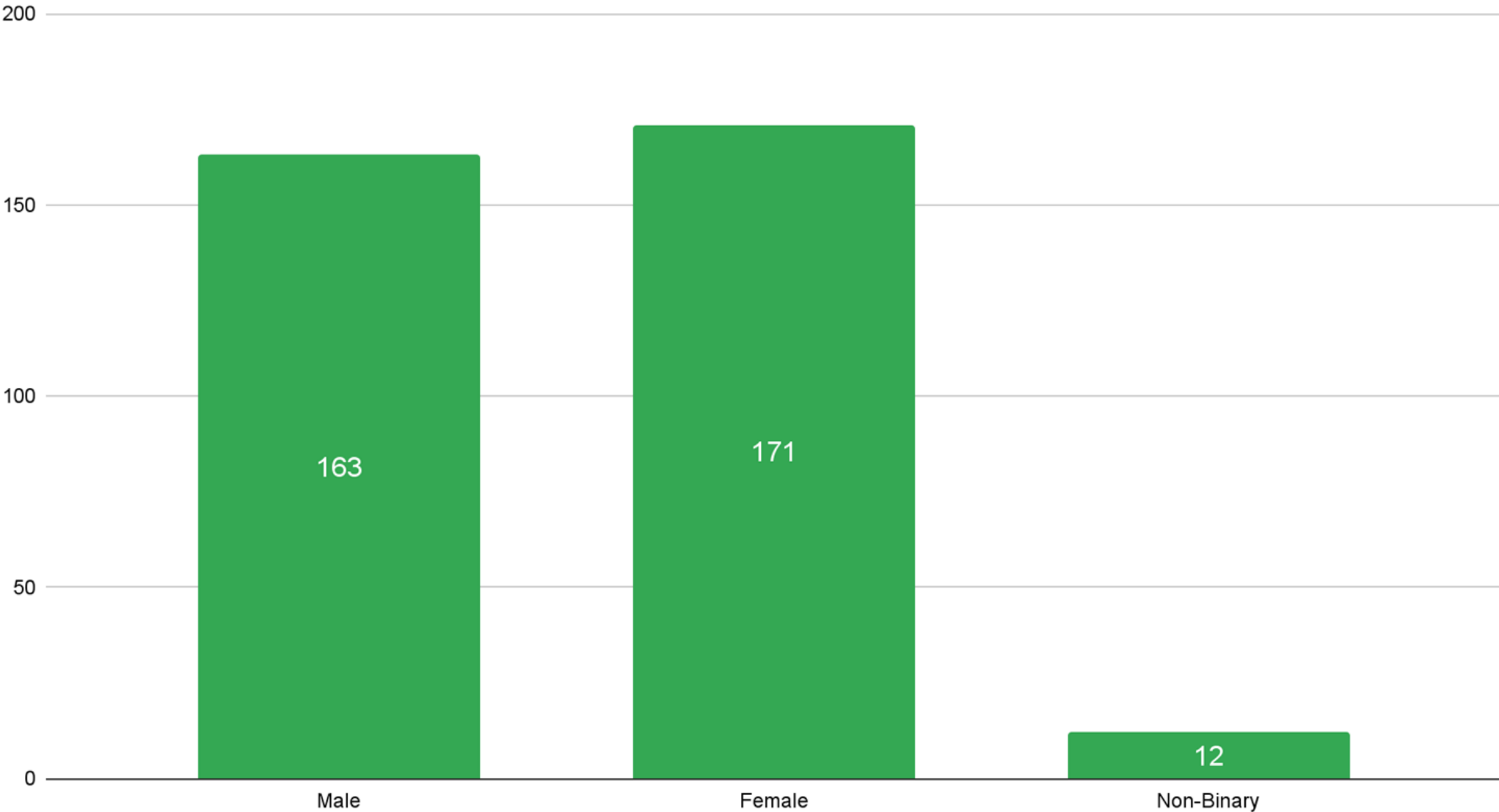

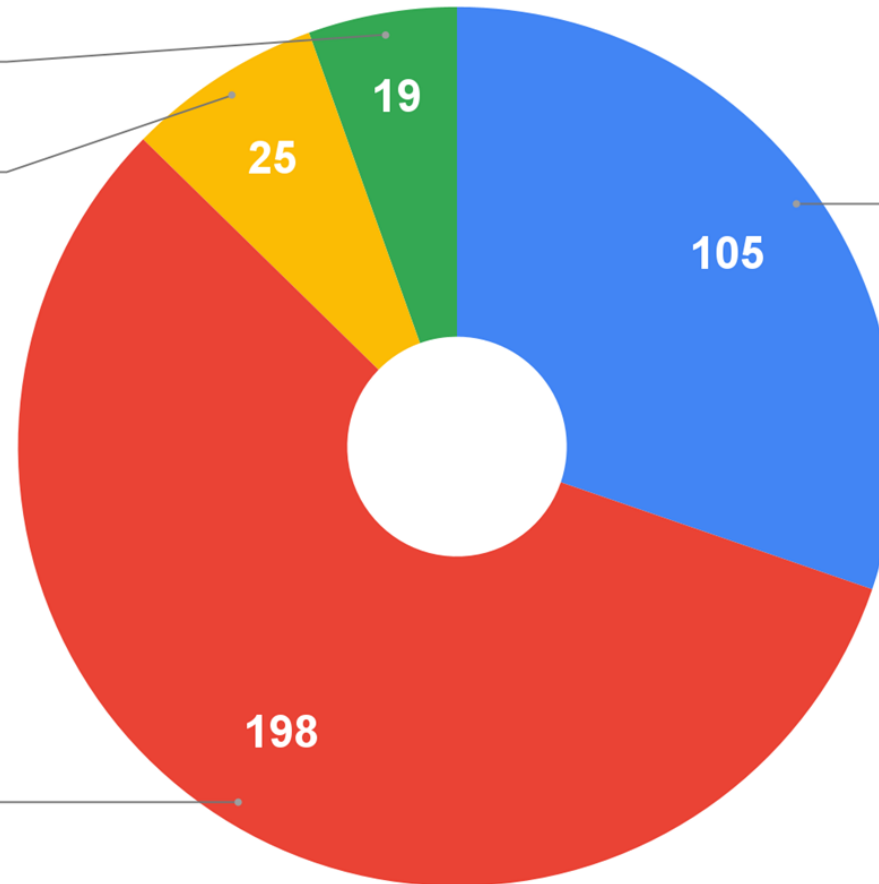

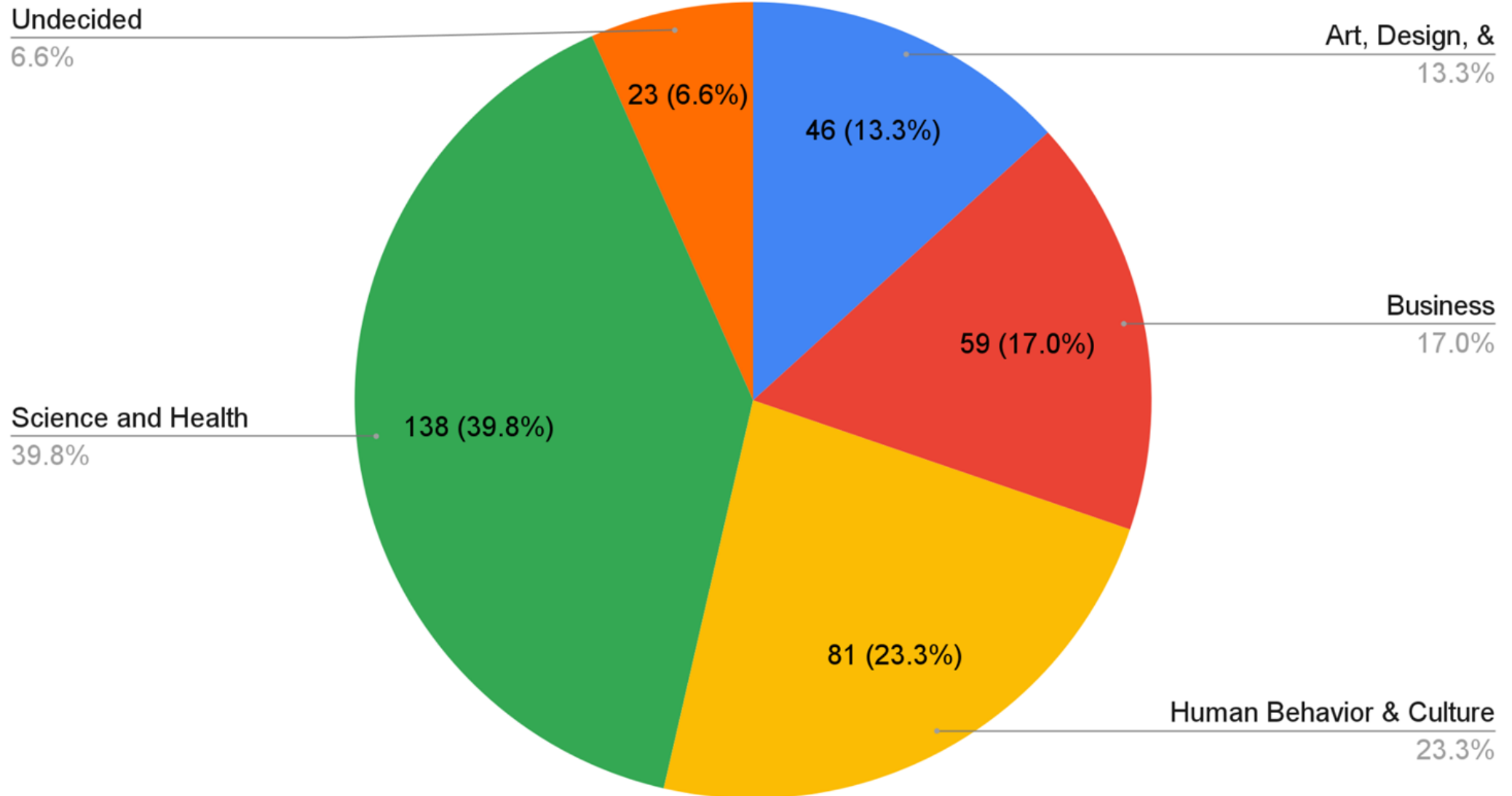

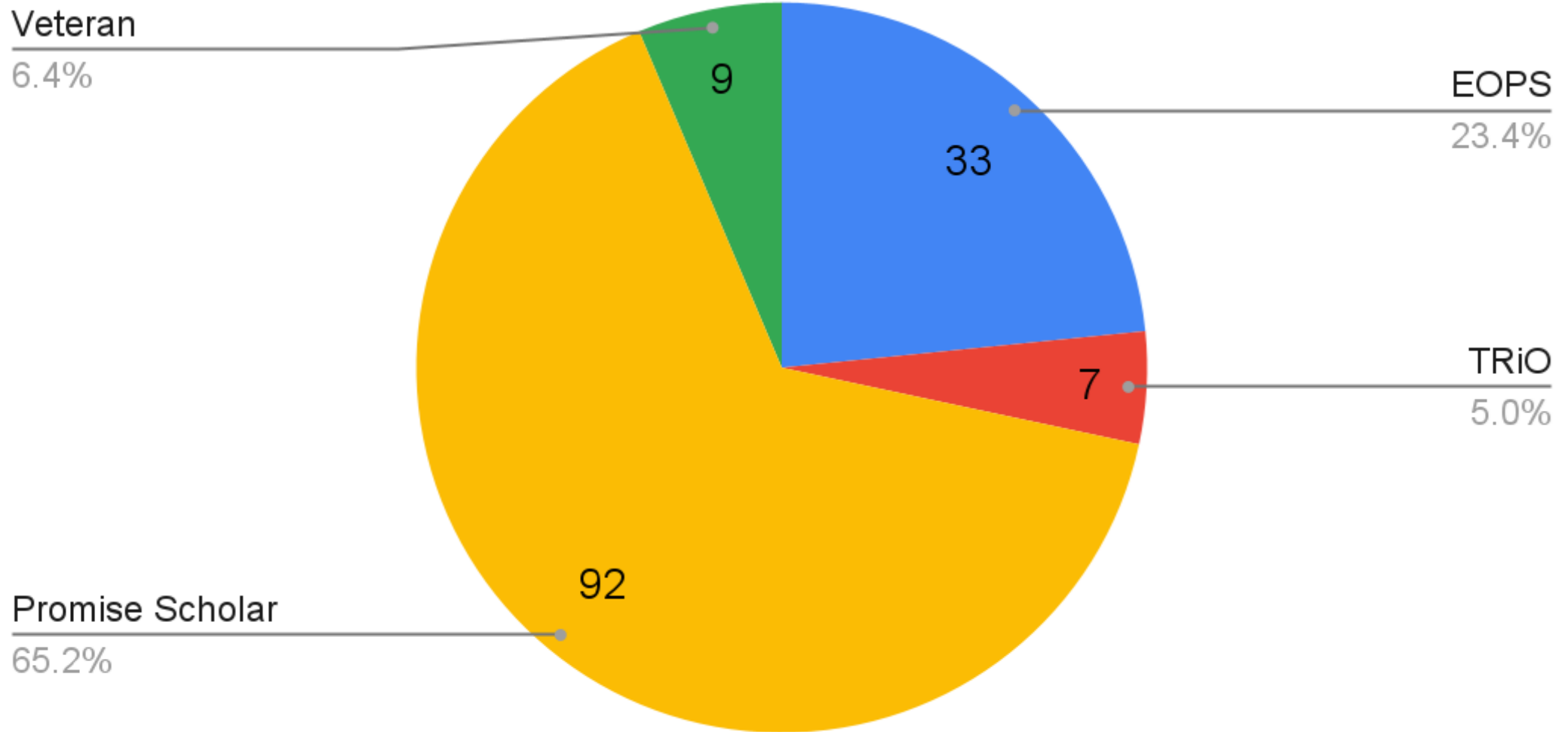

# Fall 23, Academic Probation Students in EOPS, TRiO, or are Promise Scholars or Veterans (n = 421)



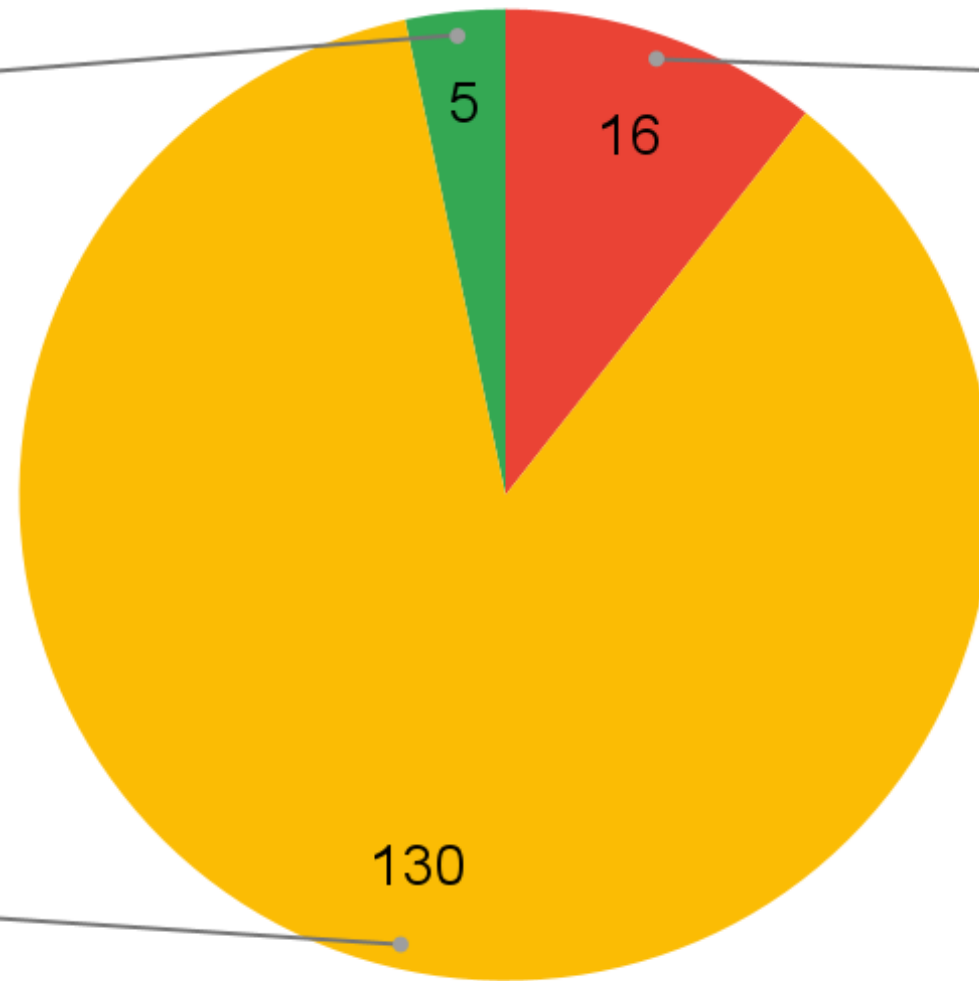
