What is UC TAG

An opportunity to receive:

- Early review of your academic records
- Guidance – It will help you to find what you need to take and to be prepared for a major before transferring
- Guaranteed admission to the UC campus of your choice – if you meet and maintain the required criteria

TAG Deadline

Submission period for:

- Fall 2025 Admission: **September 1 – 30**
- For Spring 2026 Admission: **May 1st - May 31st** (UC Merced and UC Riverside)
 - You may start your TAP application at any time
 - Upload to your information from TAP to TAG application once you complete all sections including all coursework
 - Submit your TAG application during the submission period

Important notes:

- In addition, all TAG Applicants **MUST** file a UC Admission Application
- For the TAG campus, the major on the TAG application and the Admission application must be the same

Admission Application Deadline

Complete UC Admission Application:

Fall 2025

October 1st – December 2nd, 2024

Spring 2026

July 1st – 31st, 2025

TAG application will be void, if students do not submit an Admission Application to the UC TAG campus.

Complete UC Application Update by January 31st, 2025.

General UC TAG Requirements

All TAG applicants must:

- Completed 30 UC transferrable by TAG submission Date.
- Last term of attendance before transferring must be at a California Community College

- Completed 60 UC transferrable Units by Spring prior to transfer
- At least 30 out of 60 units must be at a California Community College

- The GPA requirements for TAG 2.7-3.5 varies by campus/major/college

The criteria and GPA requirements are subject to change.

- Meet Math and English requirements by certain term

Additional TAG Criteria

- **AP Credits** – some campuses use AP credits toward 30 units toward TAG and others may not
- GPA and course requirements in Major
- Grade of C or higher for specific major courses
- No more than 19 units in Spring 2025 to Complete 60 units (junior status)
- Must have a GPA of 2.0 in all UC transferrable courses in Fall 2024 and Winter/Spring 2024 with no grade lower than C.
- At least 30 of the 60 semester units (45 of your 90 quarter units) must be completed at a California community college

Units from other colleges and universities:

Units earned at other colleges or universities can meet TAG requirements, if they are UC transferrable. The UC will evaluate these units for UC transferability once they receive your UC application. There is no guarantee your non-CCC courses will transfer to UC, which can affect your TAG eligibility and overall UC application.

Who is not eligible for TAG

Students who:

- Are in Senior-level transfer - you may not have more 80 semester units of combined CCC and other colleges and university coursework
- Have already earned a Bachelor or higher degree/are applying for second Bachelor degree
- Are seeking re-admission to a UC campus
- Are in high school

- Biotechnology: **2.5** in group of required Math, CHEM, and 3.0 for BIO Course. see the [TAG requirements for other specific requirements](#)
- Managerial Economics – **2.00** GPA in the following courses: ECON courses, Calculus courses and Statistics,
 - Additional recommended Courses: Bus. Law, Computer Science, Financial and Managerial Accounting, Public Speaking or Interpersonal Communication
- Viticulture and Enology: **3.0** in the following required courses: General chemistry series, Organic Chemistry series, Math, Physics series, and Biology series

GPA Requirements – UC Irvine



For all TAG majors: Overall GPA **3.4 in** all UC transferrable courses by the end of fall 2024 term and maintain it through end of Spring 2025

- All transfer major course prerequisites completed must meet the minimum letter grades and cumulative GPA for your chosen major.
- Must earn grade of C or 2.0 GPA in all UC transferrable courses in Fall 2024, winter and Spring 2025 term.
- **Engineering Majors** = in addition, a minimum GPA of **3.0** in major preparation courses.

Requirements – UC Merced

- Be a full-time California Community Colleges -if not must provide an explanation
- No unrepeated grade(s) of No Pass, C-, D or F in UC-transferable coursework.
- No more than two total withdrawals in major preparation courses.
- No more than one (1) major prep course where grades of no pass, C-, D or F were received, even if repeated with passing grades.

GPA Varies for each college:

- **School of Engineering** = a minimum GPA of **3.0** for all majors
- **School of Natural Sciences** = a minimum GPA of **2.9**

Selective majors are required to complete all preparatory major courses at community colleges before transferring:

- Applied Mathematics
- Biological Science
- Chemical Science
- Environmental Systems Science
- Physics

- **Psychology** major requires a minimum GPA of **3.0**

All SSHA majors are highly encouraged to complete the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) prior to enrollment at UC Merced

For all TAG majors = Overall GPA **3.4** by the end of fall 2024

and earn a **minimum 2.0 GPA** in all UC-transferable coursework in the fall 2023, winter 2024 and Fall 2024 terms with no grade lower than C.



Selective Majors:

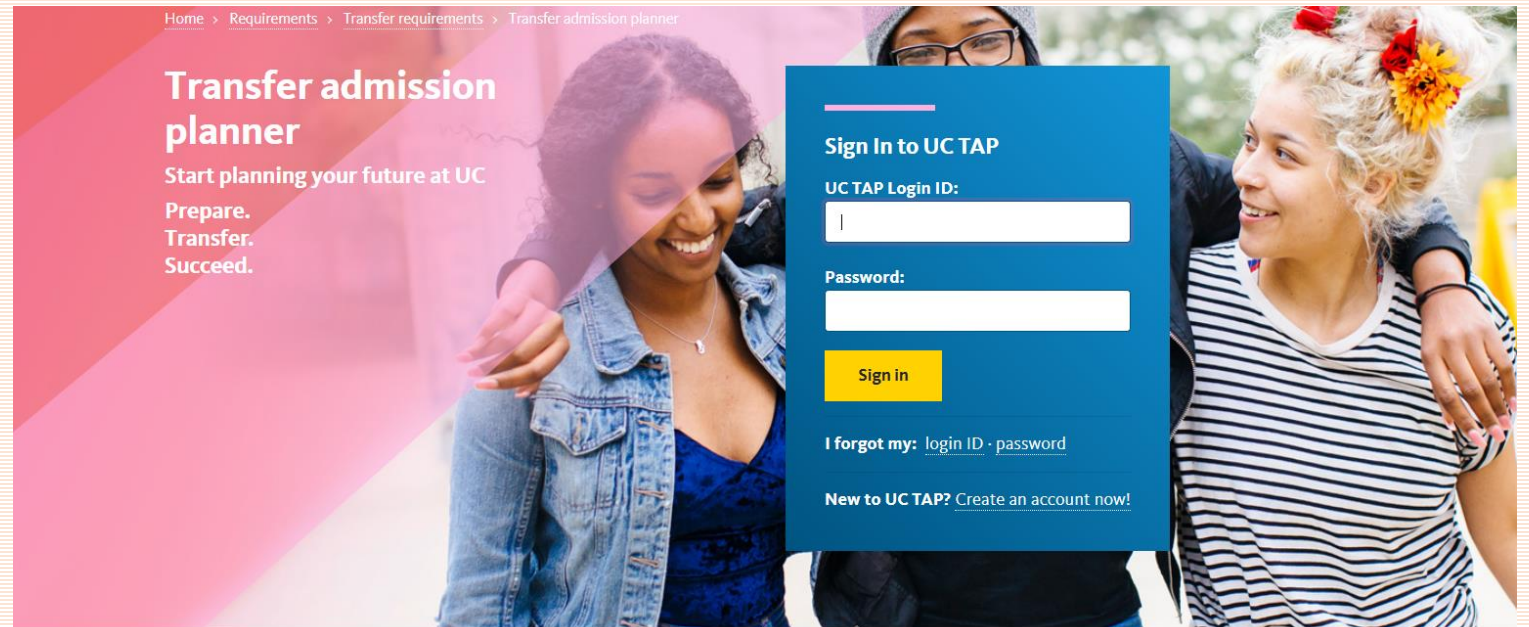

Students can use the Transfer Admission Planner to enter their coursework (completed and planned) from the very beginning of their college careers, or at any point when they decide to transfer to a UC campus.

The planner helps students track their progress toward meeting UC's minimum requirements, and allows UC staff to communicate important information to prospective transfer students.

Six out of nine UC campuses offer TAG: UC Davis, UC Irvine, UC Merced, UC Riverside, UC Santa Barbara, and UC Santa Cruz. You may file TAG to one campus only, however, you may apply for admission to as many UC campuses you wish for.

You may review the TAG criteria provided by UC campuses before completing your TAG application. The TAG criteria for each campus is available at the UC website, and at Cañada College Transfer Center webpage.

The Transfer Center provides PowerPoint and workshops that will guide you with completing the Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) and leads you to TAG application. We will also offer workshops and Q and A sessions via Zoom. Please review your eligibility and completeness of your TAG application before submitting your TAG application. The schedule of the workshop and Q&A sessions are available at the Transfer Center webpage.

Please make sure to complete your TAP application using your transcript(s), to enter all transferrable and non-transferrable courses completed, and answer all required questions.
